

Community Supported Agriculture Program Haliburton Community Organic Farm

Haliburton Farm is a seven-acre certified organic farm located on the Cordova Bay ridge at 741 Haliburton Road. Our web site at www.haliburtonfarm.org contains a great deal of background for the reader interested in learning more about the farm and the non-profit society which directs it. Our goals and accomplishments include assisting in creating a secure supply of food for Vancouver Island

We do this by demonstrating the importance and viability of protecting agricultural land, supplying one-acre parcels of land to two farmers, growing food and selling at our own farm stand and at farmers markets, offering a farming apprenticeship/mentorship program, offering workshops and facilities to professional growers and the community, promoting other organic farmers, and teaching growing skills at our weekly community work parties.

This coming season we will be operating a Community Supported Agriculture Program (CSA). A CSA is a system of farming which allows farmers and community members to be more connected. CSA members pay upfront, three times a season for a share in the harvest, have an opportunity to contribute to the decision of what is to be grown and to contribute to the production of the food. Produce is picked up at the farm on a designated day of the week. We will have a meeting in the new year of interested customers.
